



TRANSPORTATION OF POWER-SONIC BATTERIES BY ROAD

NON DANGEROUS

The Classification for this type of battery is **UN2800 BATTERIES WET, NON-SPILLABLE, ELECTRIC STORAGE**

Power-Sonic Batteries comply in full with **ADR Special Provision 598** which applies to this classification and states that:

Storage batteries are not subject to the requirements of ADR when:

- a) They are secured in such a way that they cannot slip, fall or be damaged.

(Power-Sonic batteries are transported in robust cartons with double wall thickness and extra internal packaging. Multi packed cartons are additionally fitted with dividers between each battery).

- b) They are provided with carrying devices, unless they are suitably stacked (e.g. on pallets)
- c) There are no dangerous traces of alkalis or acids on the outside
- d) They are protected against short circuit

(The terminals on all Power-Sonic batteries are insulated against short circuit and damage by terminal protectors)
